# What is advertising?





Advertising is a form of communication that attempts to influence the behavior of a defined target audience.

Any message developed and placed with the ultimate intention of persuading a group to take a specific action (such as buying a product) can be considered an ad.






To be considered an ad, messages *don't* need to specifically mention a product or service.

In fact, many of the ads you encounter on a daily basis are more about cultivating a general sense of awareness for a brand than directly influencing buying decisions right away." (Hubspot.com, 2018)

All media messages are constructed and were a choice by someone.












#### Format

Vaping content on sites like YouTube matters because research shows that exposure to pro-tobacco messages on social media PEER 2 PEER can lead to youth trying tobacco products.

Researchers from Truth Initiative and the University of Chicago found that the number of JUUL-related videos soared along with JUUL's rising sales.



### FHHS Handbook Policy

The first violation of possession (including drug paraphernalia) or consumption of alcohol, or being under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances will result in a Long-Term Suspension from school for fifteen (15) school days. All but five (5) school days of the penalty may be suspended if the student completes a drug/alcohol assessment within five (5) school business days of the violation after which the Long-Term suspension will be converted to a Short-Term Suspension of five (5) school days without need for a request by the student. The student will be expected to then participate in a program of therapy specified by the student's assistance counselor. Additionally, students will be required to provide the results of drug/alcohol monitoring monthly. If the student fails to participate in a program the Short-Term Suspension will be amended again to become a Long-Term Suspension of fifteen (15) school days, the unserved balance of which shall be immediately imposed upon the student. A second violation may result in expulsion from the San Juan Island School District. Re-admission shall be upon the approval of the Superintendent of schools or his/her designee

Marijuana affects the brain in many ways. But learning, attention, and memory are some ways that can really get in the way of doing well in school.





# Does marijuana increase or decrease heart rate?





# Increase

Using Marijuana *increases* your heart rate, as much as 20% up to100% right after use! An increase in heart rate can also trigger panic attacks, making anxiety worse.

# True

For many jobs it is still illegal to use marijuana. Many jobs, like being a police officer or boat captain, require taking a drug test before you can get hired.

Some jobs do regular drug testing, especially jobs that require driving or using machines. Chemicals in marijuana can be detected in your body for days or weeks (and even longer in your hair!).





# How does marijuana impact driving?

Studies show marijuana can *slow reaction time* and mess with your coordination. Because of this, you can get a DUI if you are caught driving while high.

Marijuana is addictive, especially for young adults and teens because of how our brains are developing.

In Washington State, marijuana is the number one reason teenagers are in treatment for addiction.

The development of schizophrenia and other psychoses have been reported as THC (the psychoactive chemical in marijuana) levels are being increased.

### DEMOCRACY

Misinformation vs. Disinformation:

Misinformation is false or incorrect information shared unintentionally.

**Disinformation** is shared with the **INTENT** to **DECEIVE**.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

~Emotional reaction: makes you mad, angry or fearful.

~Watch out for click bait! Algorithms keep putting the info in your feed.

~If it's too good to be true or too bad, vilifies: slow down and know the source of this info and don't share without fact checking first.

### WHO, HOW and WHAT are they trying to sell me?



1. Is it Factual or a Commentary/Opinion Piece Article?

2. Check date of article

3. Use more than one source for your news, balanced and reliable sources. (ex. NBC News, NY Times, BBC, NPR)


4. Photo real or out of context? Do a reverse image search on Google


