

ASSESSMENT -What's Going On Now?

- Get an accurate picture of the current conditions
- Identify what needs to be:
 - Fixed
 - Stopped
 - Improved
 - Worked on
 - Left alone



ASSESSMENT – How Did the Blues Do It?

- Decided they'd worked hard and need a nice vacation
- Wanted to go somewhere warm and affordable as a family
- Researched airlines, flights, schedules, lodging, and activities



ASSESSMENT – How Does Prevention Do It?

- Conduct surveys
- Use Photovoice
- Conduct interviews
- Look at databases
- Hold town hall meetings
- Get subjective and objective data



CAPACITY – What's In Our Toolbox?

- Identify tools we can utilize to address the problems.
- What strengths do we have? What do we need? What limitations do we have?
- Human, technical, financial, political



CAPACITY – How Did the Blues Do It?

- Looked realistically at what they could afford to spend
- Got someone to house-sit
- Researched local conditions and customs so they would be safe and respectful travelers



CAPACITY – How Does *Prevention Do It?*

- Hire staff and volunteers
- Raise money if needed
- Get donations
- Establish political connections
- Establish media connections
- Get the best equipment you can afford




PLANNING – What's Our Road Map?

- Identify evidence-based strategies.
- Set:
 - \circ Goals
 - \circ Objectives
 - Timelines, action steps, and assignments



PLANNING – How *Did the Blues Do It?*

- Made a budget for the trip
- Made packing lists and got all packed the day before
- Made a schedule for their activities based on recommendations they trust



PLANNING – How Does Prevention Do It?

- Set realistic, achievable goals, objectives, and timelines
- Have a menu of evidencebased strategies
- Assign specific tasks to specific people
- Write a clear and understandable plan that involves ALL sectors
- Communicate your plan
 effectively



IMPLEMENTATION - Let's Do This

- Time to put our plan into action!
- Use our plan as a guide, but modify if we need to along the way
- Remember to stay focused on the needs we already identified in Assessment



IMPLEMENTATION – How *Did the Blues Do It?*

- Left home with plenty of time to spare
- Stayed alert for good deals and adventures
- Checked in with each other the whole time about how it was going



IMPLEMENTATION – How Does Prevention Do It?

- Pick a strategic time to begin
- Have positive media attention ready to go
- Have your spokespeople trained and ready to go
- Document progress as you go along
- Hold everyone accountable for doing their share



EVALUATION – The Process and The Outcome

We measure:

- Process (What we did)
- Outcome (Did it work)
- What needs to be modified?



EVALUATION – How Did the Blues Do It?

- Looked at their photos and videos together and debriefed the trip
- Realized how relaxed and happy they were
- Decided that next time they were going to bring a few more things for the kids







EVALUATION – How Does *Prevention Do It?*

- Hire an outside evaluator to eliminate bias
- Conduct post-surveys
- Count participants at events
- Look back at original problems and goals
 - Were they addressed and met? Why or why not?





SUSTAINABILITY & CULTURAL COMPETENCE The Core


